A National Autistic Taskforce Forum

The forum entitled "High quality and cost effective - the future of autism care" is for approximately 50 invited participants, including representatives with responsibilities for commissioning, providing and inspecting care and support services for autistic people. It will focus on NAT's publication "An Independent Guide to Quality Care for Autistic People" which is attached to the accompanying email.

During the meeting, there will be parallel workshops focussing on the specific recommendations in this guide. Each workshop will focus on 3-4 recommendations from the NAT Guide. Each recommendation will be introduced by a brief video presentation from an individual with expertise in the topic. Participants will then discuss the recommendations and their implications for care and support for autistic people. Participants will have the opportunity to attend all three workshops over the course of the morning.
